**The Terms and Conditions for Releasing Strong Motion Records  
at Kashiwazaki-Kariwa Nuclear Power Plant,  
Tokyo Electric Power Company  
by Main Shock/after shock of 2007 Niigataken-Chuetsu-Oki Earthquake**

The strong motion records by the main shock/after shock at Kashiwazaki-Kariwa Nuclear Power Plant, Tokyo Electric Power Company during Niigataken-Chuetsu-Oki earthquake on July 16, 2007, which are released by Tokyo Electric Power Company, are distributed by Japan Association for Earthquake Engineering (JAEE). Copyright of the data belongs to Tokyo Electric Power Company, and the distribution license of the data belongs to JAEE. The user must accept the following conditions for use of the data.

1. The user must be a researcher and must agree that the data, part of the data, and all copies thereof, should be used only for research purpose related to seismology and earthquake engineering.
2. The user must not allow other persons or organizations to use, supply and sell any part of the data.
3. Japan Association for Earthquake Engineering neither accepts questions on the data nor introduces anyone in Tokyo Electric Power Company for inquiry.
4. Before shipping, the user agreement form (next page) and an international postal money order payable to Japan Association for Earthquake Engineering (JAEE) with the amount of ¥20,000/copy must be sent to Japan Association for Earthquake Engineering. Note that a bank draft and a bank money order can not be accepted.
5. When the user publishes papers and/or reports using the data, the user must acknowledge that copyright of the data belongs to Tokyo Electric Power Company, and the distribution license of the data belongs to Japan Association for Earthquake Engineering.
