- 5. Remit the payment by *international postal money order* to the amount of *8,000 yen* or *80 US dollars* for personal use and *20,000 yen* or *200 US dollars* for organizational use. Note that a bank draft and a bank money order can *not* be accepted.
- 6. Send the request form by e-mail describing the "name(s) of the requestor(s), affiliation, required number of copies, purposes and subjects of data use, address for delivering, and phone and/or fax number."
- 7. Send the user agreement by fax after making copy the next page and filling all items.
